The Hogeye Relay is a 4-leg relay event. The relay course is slightly different from that of the marathon so please pay close attention to the included maps. Full or half marathon runners may also be a member of a relay team (for an additional fee), but must run the first leg of the relay. Race start is 7:00 a.m.

Relay Exchange Zones

The Relay Exchange Zones will be clearly delineated with signs and relay flags. As runners approach the exchange zones, relay runners will be directed to exit the course and marathon/half marathon runners will be directed to continue. YOU WILL RECEIVE YOUR MEDAL AT THE EXCHANGE POINT.

RELAY TEAM MEMBERS MUST KEEP THE EXCHANGE ZONES AND THE MARATHON COURSE CLEAR. IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO CROSS THE COURSE TO GET TO EXCHANGE ZONESRELAY PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING ACROSS THE STREET SAFELY AND FOR CROSSING THE COURSE WITHOUT INTERFERING WITH ANY OF THE OTHER PARTICIPANTS. ROAD GUARDS WILL BE THERE TO HELP GUIDE YOU ACROSS THE COURSE. PLEASE BE CAREFUL OF THE TRAFFIC AND CONSIDERATE OF THE OTHER RUNNERS.

Relay Exchange Zones—While You're There

Be aware of the conditions and dress appropriately for the wait. There will not be much in the way of shelter at the exchange zones. Water and portable restrooms will be available near each exchange zone. You are responsible for your own gear and ride between exchange zones.

Relay Numbers & Timing Tag

Team members must wear a number visible on their front. The number will be color coded as to the race you are participating in. Each team will be given one timing chip attached to a bracelet. This bracelet should be worn around the runner's ankle or wrist. The bracelet with the timing chip must cross over the timing mat before it is handed off to the next runner in the indicated exchange zones. The next runner should attach the bracelet around his/her ankle or wrist before proceeding to the next exchange zone. The last runner of each team must wear the timing chip for scoring the overall team finishing time. You will return the timing chip at the finish line. THERE WILL BE A \$75 FEE FOR ANY UNRETURNED TIMING CHIPS.

Additional Information

- First leg runner is the only one needed at the starting line—2nd leg runner should proceed to Exchange Zone #1.
- **No more than one runner may cross the finish line—disqualification will occur otherwise.**
- Relay runners will receive a technical shirt with their paid entry as well as a medal upon finishing.
- All race awards will be available at the awards tent near the finish line at the conclusion of the race.
- Aid stations will be located at approximately every mile.
- Portable restrooms will be available near each relay exchange zone and at various points along the course.
- Medical personnel available at Exchange Zone #1, Marathon Turn Around, Start/Finish lines, and along the course.
- PARKING near the finish is very limited.
- Headphones discouraged. Please use extreme caution and be aware of instructions provided by road guards.
- No strollers or pets.

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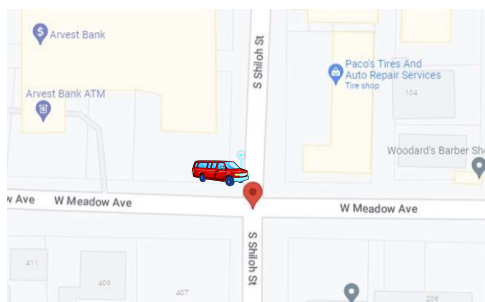


RELAY SHUTTLES FOR PARTICIPANTS ONLY

—SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE SHUTTLES— WEAR YOUR BIBS

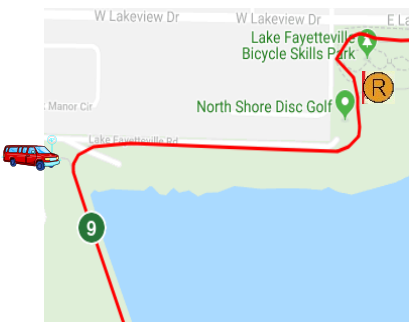
Shuttle vans will begin picking up at the relay pickup zone at the intersection of South Shiloh Street and West Meadow Avenue beginning at 6:30 a.m. You must be wearing a relay race number to board the buses. Spectators will not be allowed on the vans. Shuttle service is only available between the pickup zone and the designated relay exchange zone. You cannot ride the shuttle from one exchange zone to another without going back to the start first.

You should arrive at the shuttle stop at least ONE HOUR before you expect to start running your leg of the relay. The shuttle vans will leave approximately every 30 minutes as needed. You are responsible for getting to the exchange zone on time. The timing of the relay shuttle service is not guaranteed.



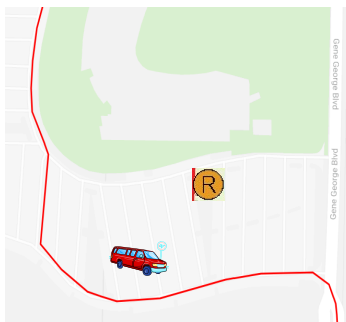
South Shiloh St and Meadow Ave,

EXCHANGE ZONES



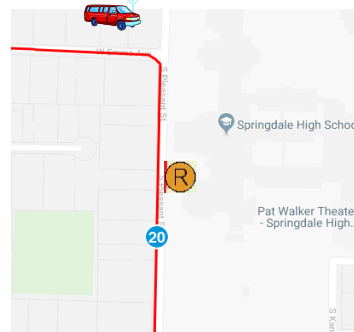
Lake Fayetteville: 1330 Lake Fayetteville Trail, Fayetteville, AR 72703

North end of Lake Fayetteville where trail begins. Runners can park in the parking lot by softball fields and must walk down Lake Fayetteville Rd to the exchange (approx .3mi)



Arvest Ballpark: 3000 Gene George Blvd, Springdale, AR 72762

Runners will run on the road and enter the parking lot. Then, exit the course after crossing the timing mat. Runners will take caution when crossing race course to their vehicles.



Springdale High School: 101 S Pleasant St, Springdale, AR 72764

Runners will run on the road to the timing mat. Parking is available at the fieldhouse across from football field, west of the school. Please refer to the attached map of the full course as it shows the full route. This snapshot is incomplete.
